ARRIVAL TO THE HOTEL

BY AIR

(from Airport Praha-Ruzyně, which is 17 km from the City Center)

There is no train or underground connection to the city! The public transport works regularly and is available till 23:45 without problem, after we suggest to take CEDAZ or taxi. In case of problems call the organizers on their cell phone.

Bus-Tram

You need to buy a ticket before getting into the vehicle. They can be bought in the arrival hall (the account desk of Prague Public Transport), in machines, or in news-stalls. The transfer ticket costs 26 CZK and is valid for 75 minutes. Take a bus no. 119 until the terminal station “Dejvická”. Then continue by tram no. 36 (direction *Vypich*) to a stop “Malovanka”, or by bus no. 217 to “Malovanka”, which is close to the hotel.

Note: you will need five tickets for the whole stay (i.e. Thursday-Sunday). There are also one-day (100 CZK) or three-day (330 CZK) tourist tickets available – according to our experience you will not exploit their value. Minibus:

In case you arrive in a group, or make one at the airport, it will pay off to take the minibus “CEDAZ”. The trip costs 480 CZK for 1-4 people to one address, or 960 CZK for 5-8 people. <http://www.cedaz.cz/about-transport-services.php>

Taxi

Taxi stations are situated right in front of arrival halls in Terminal North 1 (non-Schengen flights) – exit D and Terminal North 2 (Schengen flights) – exit E. Use the taxi company AAA (yellow *Škoda*-cars - The number is +420 14014 or +420 222 333 222, the operators speak English.). The ride may cost some 500-600 CZK. Please do not take “Fix s.r.o” airport cars (silver VW-Passats) – they have bad reputation. Please note that taxi will **not** be reimbursed!

BY TRAIN

Please note that many international trains (especially directions from Vienna, Budapest, and Dresden) do not stop at the main railway station (*Praha - Hlavní nádraží*), but in *Praha-Holešovice* station. Unfortunately, some constructions on the road make the connection a bit more complicated:

From Praha - Hlavní nádraží

Take metro C until the stop “Muzeum”, then continue by metro A until “Malostranská”, then use tram n. 22 to the stop “Malovanka” (direction *Bílá Hora*), which is close to the hotel.

From Nádraží Praha-Holešovice

Take the tram n. 12 to the stop “Malostranská” (direction *Sídliště Barrandov*) and then change for tram n. 22 until the stop “Malovanka” (direction *Bílá Hora*). Or you can go by metro C until “Muzeum”, then continue by metro A to “Malostranská”, and from there take tram n. 22 to “Malovanka”.

Taxis from the stations

Taxis in railway stations still have a bad reputation. Make sure that the taximeter is working and require a receipt. Prices: 28 CZK for kilometer, 6 CZK waiting-fee for a minute. Additionally 40 CZK will be preset as a starting-fee. If you want to be secure, call the taxi company “AAA”. The number is +420 14014 or +420 222 333 222, the operators speak English.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Internet

At the Pyramida hotel all rooms should be equipped with Internet – free of charge at low speed, charged for high connection. At the Faculty of Philosophy and Arts, WiFi is available via EDUROAM network, which you can set up in advance.

Currency

There are plenty of exchange offices in the city-centre and ATMs at every corner. The Czech Crown (“Česká koruna”) is currently dropping: the rate rises above 25 CZK for 1 EUR. Euros are accepted selectively and usually only to some amount.

Weather

Generally, local weather in late November is not very nice, being usually cold, cloudy, and rainy. This year, however, weather seems to be above the average: temperatures are estimated to reach 9°C at the highest, dropping to 0°C at night. Snow should not occur yet.
